Saturday, Jan 12 at 1-6:30PM – Student Orientation, Plenary Session and Mixer:

Hear welcoming remarks from ASHRAE President Sheila Hayter followed by presentations by recipients of last year's Grant program, an awards ceremony and talk from Dr. Christine Darden.

The plenary session will feature a keynote from Grant Imahara – host of Discovery Channel's Mythbusters for almost a decade. Finally, it is encouraged to attend the YEA/Student Mixer to meet and socialize with other students and YEA members.

Sunday, Jan 13th at 8AM-1:30PM – Student Program:

The program will feature a discussion on ASHRAE's Design Competition, technical talks, a group design build challenge, plus roundtable discussions over lunch.

Sunday, Jan. 13th at 1:30PM-2:30 or 2:30-3:00 – Student Tour:

See the Kendeda Building for Innovative Sustainable Design and the Living Building Challenge at Georgia Institute of Technology.

The recipient is encouraged to attend any additional events associated with the conference and is not limited to the events mentioned above. See ASHRAE.org for additional information on conference events.

Recipient of this sponsorship will be required to provide a short contribution regarding your experience to our February Newsletter (due January 24th). Don't forget to take pictures!

Basic Criteria which all sponsorships are granted:

Full time enrollment in a college, university, or technical institute.

Study that is applicable to service in the HVAC&R profession.

A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.8 on a scale where 4.0 is the highest.

Association with the region covered by Connecticut ASHRAE (Connecticut and Western MA) by attendance of school in the area or as a resident.

Student membership in the Connecticut Chapter of ASHRAE

This award has a maximum value of \$1500.00 and will be paid as a reimbursement for actual expenses incurred by the recipient. Proof of these expenses must be submitted within 90 days from the date the expense was incurred. Expenses to consider include but are not limited to airfare/transportation, lodging, meals, and registration. The recipient is also required to submit a short entry to our February newsletter detailing their experience at the conference. Reimbursement to be issued to the recipient upon receiving proof of expenses and newsletter entry.

DEADLINE: Students must submit the sponsorship application with supporting documents by MONDAY DECEMBER 3, 2018 to be considered. Applicants will receive a confirmation email when this application is received via email. Recipient to be notified by December 7th.
